Public transport or taxi is recommended due to very limited parking.

Blue Tower is adjacent to the stop “Vleurgat” which is served by:

- Tram 93 (direction LEGRAND) or Tram 94 (direction MUSEE DU TRAM/TRAMMUSEUM) every few minutes from Louise/Louiza metro station.
- Bus 38 (direction HEROS/HELDEN) every 10 minutes from Central Station.
- Bus 60 (direction UCCLE CALEVOET/UKKEL KALEVOET) every 15 minutes from Schuman.

Buy your transport tickets at a kiosk or vending machine before boarding the bus, tram, metro or train.

If flying into Brussels Airport (BRU), go to Level -1 of the terminal for Brussels Airport-Zaventem railway station. Buy a ticket to Brussels: it is the same price for any rail station in Brussels Zone, so no need to specify which station: a single ticket is €9.00 (this does not include local public transport: metro, tram or bus, which needs a separate ticket).

There are six trains per hour to **Bruxelles-Midi/Brussel-Zuid** rail station, travel time 20 minutes (final destinations of the trains are usually somewhere beyond Brussels, such as Gent/Gand, Oostende, Mons/Bergen or Tournai/Doornik).

There are also two trains per hour from the airport direct to **Bruxelles-Luxembourg/Brussel-Luxemburg**, which is slightly nearer. These trains have final destination of Charleroi or Dinant.

From Bruxelles-Midi/Brussel-Zuid rail station (also the point where you will arrive if taking an international high speed train: Thalys, Eurostar, TGV, ICE), take Metro 2 or 6 towards ELISABETH for 3 stops, get off at LOUISE/LOUIZA, then take Tram 93 (direction LEGRAND) or Tram 94 (direction MUSEE DU TRAM/TRAMMUSEUM) for 4 stops to VLEURGAT.

From Bruxelles-Luxembourg/Brussel-Luxemburg rail station, leave by the main station entrance and head diagonally to the right (Place du Luxembourg), cross the road (Rue de Trèves). Take Bus 38 from the stop on the corner of the square (outside “The Beer Factory” bar) in the direction of HEROS/HELDEN for 6 stops to VLEURGAT.

Hotel suggestions

Suggestions for nearby hotels (Avenue Louise area) are below.

Alternatively, there are hotels in the city centre which will mean a slightly longer trip to ERTICO.

3-star Accor chain hotel: **Ibis Styles Brussels Louise**. 6 minutes' walk from ERTICO.

4-star NH hotels in Brussels, the nearest is **NH Brussels Louise** 18 minutes' walk from ERTICO or 3 stops by tram 93 or 94 (Stéphanie/Stefania to Vleurgat), or **NH Brussels Stephanie** (21 minutes' walk or the same tram route).
